AGES 11-18

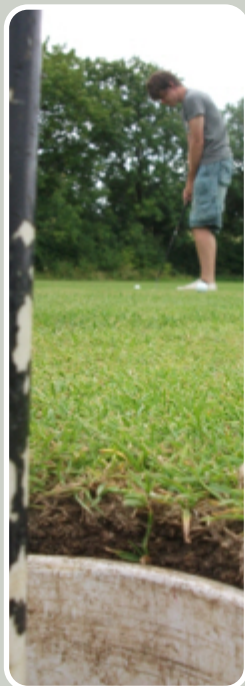

INSURANCE Heath Evangelical Church is insured for Public Liability. This insurance provides for protection for campers should they have an accident which was due to negligence of the leaders or organisers of Heath Evangelical Church Camps. Would you please note, however, that the above insurance does not cover personal accident cover for the campers. If therefore a camper receives injury for which Heath Evangelical Church, its leaders or organisers are not liable, then there will be no entitlement to payment from Heath Evangelical Church's insurers. Parents/individuals should consider taking out their own Personal Accident Insurance should they decide that such cover is necessary.

CONDUCT We will do everything we can to make your time at camp as enjoyable as it can be. In order to ensure that this happens, however, and in order that the camps provide a safe environment for all, there will have to be some rules. If you book to come, your booking will be construed as acceptance of these rules.

ACTIVITIES The submission of the booking form will be construed as approval for your child (anyone under 18) to be involved in any of the activities/sports organised at camp. Details of the activities/sports that may take place can be obtained from the respective leader via the relevant booking secretary. Should there be any activities/sports which you do not wish your child to be involved in, you must inform the relevant camp leader at the time of booking.

[Transport for Senior Camp is by arrangement. Transport to and from the other camps and throughout the week is available as required at no extra cost.]

A £25 non-returnable deposit should be paid for EACH person booking. Cheques are to be made payable to Heath Evangelical Church Camps. Balance to be paid by the end of June 2011. Payments can be made by instalments [please ask your booking secretary]. A £10 discount will apply for a second or subsequent child from the same family booking for camp. Please give details when booking for camp.

GENERAL The date for eligibility for each camp is 31st August 2011. Heath Evangelical Church complies with prepared Health & Safety, and Child Protection policies. Each camp will have a qualified first aider/medical officer.
